



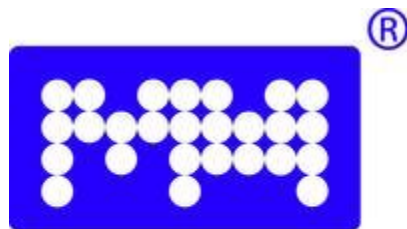

## **TOURNAMENT REGISTRATION FEES**

The board of Tennis NB has approved a slight increase in the fee structure for all Tennis NB sanctioned events (excluding the NB Open and the East Coast Open). This is the first increase in tournament fees in over 7 years. The new fees for the 2011 season are as follows:

Adult: One Event: \$25 Two Events: \$35

Junior: One Event: \$20 Two Events: \$25

# **2011 TENNIS NB** **PROVINCIAL TEAM** **PROGRAM**

Tennis New Brunswick will again be offering a Provincial Team Program which is designed to regroup the top committed junior players in the province to prepare them for the summer competitive season, provincially, regionally and nationally. The Provincial Team Program will also serve as the foundation for our 2013 Canada Games for both identification of potential athletes and the training component of the process. Participants must be planning on participating in at least 1 (one) ATA Circuit Event and the Outdoor Junior Atlantics to be included in the program and must attend training camps as scheduled. Additional competitive opportunities are available and players will be encouraged to take part in these as well. The camps are scheduled to accommodate the tournament schedule. As our Provincial Program will also be serving as our Canada Games Program for the 2013 Canada Summer Games, anyone interested in being considered for the Canada Games Team **MUST** be taking part in the Provincial Program.
